Northpoint Bible College and Graduate School enters into this new articulation agreement with Faith Bible College International for their students to enter the Master's program at Northpoint Bible College and Graduate School. This agreement supersedes the previous agreement from 2017.

If a student applies to the Graduate School of Northpoint Bible College who has a certificate from a three-year institute or who has graduated from a college that does not have accreditation that is recognized or endorsed by the United States Department of Education, the student may be conditionally accepted into the MA program providing the following criterion are met:

- Complete the Bible-knowledge entrance exam and score a minimum of 70%.
- Submit a new and unmarked copy of a previously submitted research paper from FBCI with a minimum of 7 pages and a maximum of 15 pages. This paper will be reviewed by a graduate school professor. A minimum score of 70% must be achieved.
- Once the above two-criterion have been favorably met, the applicant will be fully accepted into the program.
- There will be no advanced standing for the MA program. All 48 credit hours required for the program must be completed and a minimum GPA of 2.7 must be met to remain in the program.

This articulation agreement will be honored between the two schools when signatures are properly affixed.
